- b) in respect of children in classes VI to VIII- within a walking distance of three km of the neighbourhood.

In areas with difficult terrain, risk of landslides, floods, lack of roads and in general, danger for young children in the approach from their homes to the school, the school will be located in such a manner as to avaoid such dangers, by reducing the limits specified above.

For children from small hamlets, as identified by the State Government, where no school exists within the area or limits of neighbourhood specified above, adequate arrangements, such as residential facilities and other necessary facilities shall be made, for providing elementary education in a school in relaxation of the limits specified above.
